VII. Executive Director's Staff Report

Funding

We have not received our funds, nor or any reports updated for this month on the State website. This is most likely due to the holiday weekend. As you can see in the reports the past year did show an increase over the previous year of approximately 2.2%, or \$46,503.39.

An Illinois American easement request was received and is under review. The document has been forward to Illinois American with our comments and once signed by them, it will be brought to the Board for action. There are many provisions in the agreement to make certain the grounds are not damaged, and a \$38,000 onetime payment, which is an average of our last two years of water usage.

Grants

We were awarded the \$30,000 grant from St. Clair County for energy efficient lighting at MMMP.

We are currently filling out an application to DCEO and Ameren to replace the lighted bollards at the parks with new LED lighting. Pyramid Electric and EMS are working with us on the application. It should be in the \$60,000 -75,000 range in addition to the original \$30,000 in the St. Clair County Grant. The funds are supplied to DCEO by Ameren and distributed from DCEO.

MMMP

We have found a fairly significant hole at the park on the east side of the geyser. After speaking with TWM, we contacted SCI Engineering to decide the best action to take. The hole is approximately 18" x 18" and is 4-5 feet deep. Paul Homann is now contacting a drilling company to put a concrete slurry in it to seal it off.

We met with the NPS and a representative from VISTA, a division of AmeriCorps. The mission for the next year is to involve East St. Louis youth in National Park Service activities and perhaps share some programs at our location.

Staff, Mr. Hier and Colonel Atkins were interviewed by Mary Delach on 20th anniversary of geyser, from St. Louis Public Radio, 90.7 KWMU.

Payments

The Woodriver Triathlon, Autism Bike at Dawn have completed their events and payment has been sent.

Events

Libby Rueter from Watershed CAIRNS has contacted us regarding beach party on Mosenthein Island. They will be working with various agencies. No requests were made of the District other than current owner/contact information.

We met with representatives of Lewis and Clark Community College in Godfrey and reviewed their plans for more trails and connectors.

We are working with NPS on 50th Anniversary of Arch. As it stands as of this meeting there will be an Arch Fest at Kiener Plaza on October 22nd-24th. On the 24th, we will have a small celebration with Board members from MEPRD, Gateway Center, and a few invited individuals honoring the 20th Anniversary of the Geyser at our location at 6:00 p.m. Light refreshments will be provided and fireworks will follow provided by the Arch fest and the arch will be lit up in gold for the 50th Anniversary.

Attended the Swansea Fire and Police Children's Camp which was funded with money from our Swansea Patriots grant last year. 42 children were afforded two days of camp like activities in Swansea Parks.
