VII. Executive Director's Staff Report

Funding

We have received our funds and they have shown an increase over the previous year, same month of \$8,312. We also received our verification today of our next installment with an increase of \$1,450. For the first two months in our new budget year, we are \$9,762 over the same two months last year.

The Illinois American easement request was sent to you under separate cover. The Illinois American engineer has indicated that it has passed their legal review and is awaiting the proper signatures. Once those are received, we will place the appropriate resolution on the Board agenda for consideration.

Grants

All paperwork has been submitted for the \$30,000 grant from St. Clair County for energy efficient lighting at MMMP. We are awaiting the Notice to Proceed. Pyramid Electric indicates the work could be completed within 30 days.

DCEO has indicated that all application awards are on hold because of the State budget issue. It may be several months before we hear anything on the balance of the lighting replacement, if at all in this budget year.

MMMP

The hole at the park on the east side of the geyser will be repaired shortly. Dennis Munie will be filling it with a porous type concrete mix that will fill in all the crevices. Based on estimates, it will take between \$1,000 and \$1,500, depending on the depth.

The interview by Mary Delach on the 20th anniversary of geyser, from St. Louis Public Radio, 90.7 KWMU will be released near October 20th. We will send an advance notice or a copy of the program.

Staff is currently working on the programming for the October 24 event for the 20th Anniversary of the Gateway Geyser to coincide with the 50th Anniversary of the Gateway Arch.

Resolution 14-47 is a resolution required by the Economic Development Administration to secure funding as a participant for the Front Street project.

The Geyser will close for the season after the ceremony.

Events

Bryan and I attended a meeting with Great Rivers Greenway at their office and visitors from Memphis, Tennessee. The purpose was to outline what each of our districts do respectively with our funding, how we came into existence and what the jurisdictional makeup of the Boards are.

Tom Bradley, Superintendent of the National Park Service at the Jefferson National Expansion Memorial will be retiring at the end of October. He wanted to wish our district well and said it was a pleasure to have dealt with us over the years.

We have two sponsorship events on the agenda. One for the Freaky 5 K Run in Caseyville with a request for \$664.37 and the Gingerbread 5K Run in the City of Belleville for \$2,500.

Planner Bryan Werner outlined the current applications for reimbursement and funding from the following agencies:

City of O'Fallon reimbursement request for the Madison Street/Illini Connector in the amount of \$82,788.19 for the project.

The Village of Millstadt has requested funding for the Asphalt Walking Trail in the Millstadt Community Park in the amount of \$15,000 for the \$60,000 project.

The St. Clair County Transit District has requested funding for the MetroBikeLink – Fairview Heights section in the amount of \$300,000 for the \$1,300,000 project.

The Village of Maryville has requested funding for the Illinois Route 159 –MCT Schoolhouse Trail Connector in the amount of \$11,400 for the \$69,130 project.
